ISO 22000 is an International Standard of descriptive nature for management systems—it is not the intent to define specific requirements for food safety. It is a voluntary management system as-

sisting organizations to objectively demonstrate conforming to best food safety practices and methods with focus on implementing and maintaining a coherent food safety system combining inputs from regulatory requirements and other food safety management systems. Thereof, ISO 22000 enables organizations to align its food safety practices and methods with International Standards ISO 9001:2000, ISO 14001:2004 and other recognizable management systems protocols such as ILO-OSH.

Regulatory requirements may include cGMP (current Good Manufacturing Practices) FDA, GAP—Good Agricultural Practices, GHP—Good Hygienic Practices, GDP—Good Distribution Practices, GVP—Good Veterinary Practices, SSOPs, NOAA QMP Food Management System and other specifics requiring that a given organization meets.

BRS grants recognition to present the BRS approved ISO 22000 Lead Assessor / Lead Auditor Courses. The course meets the training requirements for the certification of professionals for BRS GlobalNet international registration signatory requirements as well other bodies in agreement with these multilateral agreement of understanding.
